AUGUST 4, 2012

1. THE CONFLICTING DATE IN 2016 WITH THE LEXINGTON SECTIONAL AND CINCINNATI REGIONAL HAS BEEN RESOLVED. CINCINNATI WILL MOVE TO A JUNE DATE. THANKS TO ALL WHO WORKED ON THIS AND MADE IT HAPPEN IN CINCINNATI.

2. VENUE FOR THE LOUISVILLE/LEXINGTON REGIONAL—THE DISTRICT BOARD WILL NOT GRANT A SANCTION FOR THE REGIONAL TO BE HELD AT THE RAMADA INN IN 2013 WHICH WILL GIVE THE COMMITTEE AMPLE TIME TO FIND AN EQUAL OR BETTER VENUE FOR THE REGIONAL.

3. CURRENT DISTRICT 11 PRESIDENT BILL SENTMEN AND CURRENT DISTRICT 11 VICE PRESIDENT, GEORGIA BANSINGER WERE RE-ELECTED FOR TWO YEAR TERMS BY ACCULIMATION. CHERYL SCHNEIDER HAS BEEN APPOINTED SECRETARY, REPLACING NANCY SACHS WHO HELD THIS POSITION FOR OVER 20 YEARS.

4. THE DISTRICT 11 BOARD VOTED TO NOT FORCE DAYTON/COLUMBUS TO SPLIT THE NEXT REGIONAL WITH EVANSVILLE DUE TO THE LOW TURNOUT THE LAST FEW YEARS. IF SPLIT IN THE FUTURE IT WILL HAVE TO BE WITH CINCINNATI OR LOUISVILLE/LEXINGTON. SPLIT REGIONALS ARE A REAL PROBLEM AS IT SEEMS BOTH GROUPS LOSE IN ATTENDANCE.
