RULES OF ORDER

I want to remind everyone about the proper manner in which members of our assembly (Board Meeting) should address each other when discussing or debating an issue .

First of all, the debate must be confined to the merits of the pending question that is on the floor. This means we should not vary off the subject into other areas. Speakers must address their remarks to the Chair, maintain a courteous tone, and especially in reference to any divergence of opinion- should avoid injecting a personal note into the debate. To this end, speakers must never attack or make any allusion to the motives of members. Speakers should refer to officers only by title, and should avoid the mention of other member's names as much as possible.
